2004 14%	Pieve Vecchia, Soave Superiore A well-balanced French oak-aged Soave in a deliciously soft but full style from the masterful Fasoli Gino team. There are nuances of apricot and almond which border on the aromatic and a pleasantly firm citrus edge.	£21
2006 13%	Vernaccia di San Gimignano Clean lines and a smoothly sophisticated appeal, a wine that punches above its weight, crisp and clean on the palate with a memorable almond twist on the finish	£20
2006 13.5% non organic	Vermentino, Tanca Sa Contissa The wine is straw yellow in colour with a hint of green, it has an intense fruity aroma and a harmonious, well balanced flavour.	£19
2005 13.5%	Offida Pecorino, Tenuta Cocci Grifoni Hand Picked 100% Pecorino a unique wine of great character and balance. The nose is alive with honeyed, peach blossom aroma and the palate has rich, well rounded ripe fruit	£21

2005 12.5%	Primitivo A fairly soft red from Puglia, not in the big rich style of American Zinfandel, but with nicely balanced dark berry and damson fruit.	£13 – 750ml £3– 175 ml
2005 12.5%	Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Ripe bramble and dark berry fruit with well integrated but noticeable tannins, bags of fruit and a great depth.	£14- 750ml £3.75 - 175ml
2005 12.5%	Nero d'Avola Made from hand-harvested grapes, this is fruitier than most due to its vinification method, which involves a two day maceration with the juice absorbing plenty of colour and flavour from the pigment-rich skins. The result is an intensely ripe, juicy, with plenty of bold spicy fruit on the palate.	£14- 750ml £3.75 - 175ml

2006 12.5% non organic	Brindisi Blending the finest native Puglian grapes; Negroamaro, Malvasia Nera and Montepulciano this highly acclaimed and award winning wine has a reputation for its bounty of rich raisin, plum and sweet spice aromas and full, rich dark fruit layered with bitter sweet chocolate and black olive flavours. Warm and supple tannins give a full bodied but smooth finish.	£15- 750ml £4 - 175ml
2005 12.5%	Chianti, Tenuta San Vito Matured in oak for 8 months, this is a medium bodied with a fresh raspberry fruity flavour and clear ruby red colour.	£15
2004 13%	Valpolicella, La Corte del Pozzo, Fasoli Gino This is an engaging blend of Corvina, Rondinella and Molinara. It's juicy and refreshing with delicate flavours of plum and cranberry	£17
2005 13.5%	Pinotage, The Ruins, South Africa It expresses the quality of Pinot Noir and Hermitage without bitterness. It is an intense ruby colour with lovely aromas of black fruit.	£17
2003 13% non organic	Salice Salentino Riserva, Leone de Castris Ruby red colour tending to garnet with age. Intense, delicate bouquet; dry, harmonious and warm flavours.	£19
2005 13.5% non organic	Barbera d'Alba, Batasiolo Sometimes known as 'the people's wine' in Piemonte because it's so widely produced, this heavyweight barbera should certainly postpone the revolution.
